<b>BILL</b>	<b>TITLE</b>	<b>SUMMARY</b>
AB 601 (Eggman)	Residential care facilities for the elderly: licensing and regulation.	Expands and further specifies licensure requirements for Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly.
AB 614 (Brown)	Health care standards of practice.	Authorizes the California Department of Public Health (DPH) to use a streamlined administrative process to update regulatory references to health care standards of practice adopted by a state or national association when outdated standards are referenced in the California Code of Regulations (CCR).
AB 664 (Dodd)	Medi-Cal: universal assessment tool report.	Requires, on or before January 1, 2017, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Department of Social Services (DSS), and the California Department of Aging (CDA) to, in consultation with a stakeholder group, to evaluate and report to the Legislature on outcomes and lessons of the existing Medi-Cal universal assessment tool (UAT) pilot.
AB 1436 (Burke)	In-home supportive services: authorized representative.	Allows In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) applicants and recipients to designate an authorized representative.
ABX2-15 (Eggman)	End of life.	Enacts the End of Life Option Act in California. Sunsets in 2026.
SB 19 (Wolk)	Physician Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment form: electronic registry pilot.	Establishes a Physician Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment (POLST) eRegistry Pilot.
SB 36 (Hernandez)	Medi-Cal: demonstration project.	Authorizes DHCS to request one or more temporary waiver extensions to continue the operation of, and the authorities

		provided under, the current “California Bridge to Reform Demonstration,” the state’s Section 1115 Medicaid waiver.
SB 196 (Hancock)	Elder abuse: protective orders.	Authorizes, as of July 1, 2016, a county adult protective services agency to file a petition for issuance of a protective order on behalf of an elder or dependent adult.
SB 575 (Liu)	Long-term care insurance.	Requires long-term care insurance carriers to annually notify policyholders with a vested contingent benefit upon lapse or a shortened benefit (“nonforfeiture benefit”), and any designated third-party, that the benefit is available and how they may request more information about the benefit.
SB 613 (Allen)	State Department of Public Health: dementia guidelines: workgroup.	Requires DPH to convene a workgroup to update the 2008 Guidelines for Alzheimer’s Disease Management in CA. Requires DPH to submit a report of the updates and recommendations from the working group to the Legislature on or before March 1, 2017.
SB 675 (Liu)	Hospitals: family caregivers.	Requires a hospital to provide an opportunity for a patient who has been admitted to the hospital as an inpatient to identify a caregiver to assist in post-hospital care.
AJR 8 (Brown)	Older Americans Act of 1965.	Urges Congress to reauthorize the Older Americans Act of 1965.
ACR 38 (Brown)	California Task Force on Family Caregiving.	Establishes the California Task Force on Family Caregiving.

AB 332 (Calderon)	Long-term care insurance.	Establishes a task force to design a statewide, public long-term care insurance program.
AB 1261 (Burke)	Community-based adult services: adult day health care centers.	Codifies the Community-Based Adult Services (CBAS) program and its requirements as a Medi-Cal benefit to be provided at licensed adult day health care (ADHC) centers.
AB 1526 (Brown)	Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System survey: caregiver module.	Directs DPH, by January 1, 2017, to include the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Caregiver Module in the annual Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) survey.
